



## Pre-Boarding Checklist For Dogs

**New Client**

1. Owner Registration Form
2. Healthy Pet History

**Existing Client**

**Vaccination**

The following vaccines are required for boarding, daycare, and grooming. Please be sure to bring proof of vaccination

1. Distemper (DHPP)
2. Bordetella
3. Canine Influenza (H3N8)
4. Leptospirosis 4-way
5. Rabies
6. Negative Fecal (within last 12 months if on monthly heartworm preventative or in last 3 months if not)

**Missing Vaccinations**

We can administer them while your pet is with us, for an additional charge. In addition, should your pet exhibit any health problems, the appropriate treatment will be initiated at an additional cost.

**Medication Supply**

If your pet is on any medication, please call For Pet's Sake for approval prior to boarding. Some pets will be required to board in hospital depending on the type of medications.

1. Adequate Supply for Duration of Stay
2. Prescriptions in Original Container (No Exceptions)

**Feeding Procedure**

All guests are fed twice a day. Please choose one of the below options:

1. Our in-house diet of Hill's Science Diet I/D Low Fat
2. Bring Food From Home (Additional charges apply. Please see Feeding Procedure Handout for further instructions)

**Flea Prevention**

For the safety our guests we recommend the use of a monthly flea preventative. All pets checking into our facility will be checked for fleas. If fleas are present, we will treat your pet, and you will be responsible for all additional charges.

For Pet's Sake does its best every day to take care of your pet and make their stay with us as enjoyable as possible. To help us facilitate this, please inform the kennel staff of any special needs pertaining to your pet. These would include any allergies, anxiety issues, aggressive behavior, or any other health concerns.
